Each year, the Outreach Committee of the Vestry accepts grant applications from organizations which address education, health & welfare, safety, homelessness, child activities for children in shelters, after-school care, and transportation. This year, the Outreach Committee is pleased to announce that the parish is funding 11 organizations through \$25,000 from the annual budget allotment, and an additional \$8,000 from the Outreach Gifts Fund. DALLAS CASA

Grant Amount: \$3,000

Grant Purpose: for program funding to increase the number of volunteer advocates so more children can be served Mission: The mission of Dallas CASA is to recruit, train and supervise volunteers to represent the best interest of abused and neglected children while they are in protective care.

DME EXCHANGE OF DALLAS

Grant Amount: \$1,500

Grant Purpose: to fund repair, sanitization and distribution of medical

equipment

Mission: DME collects, refurbishes, and distributes gently used medical equipment free of charge to Dallas County residents who have a financial need, no health insurance, or a gap in coverage.

GENESIS WOMEN'S SHELTER

Grant Amount: \$3,000

Grant Purpose: for Camp G, the summer and holiday program for children living at the Emergency Shelter and Transitional Living Facility Mission: Genesis Women's Shelter provides safety, shelter and support for women who have experienced domestic violence, and to

raise awareness regarding its cause, prevalence and impact.

HAPPY HOMES PRE-SCHOOL OF SOUTH AFRICA

Grant Amount: \$3,000

Grant Purpose: for office supplies, such as a computer, fax and copy machines, and for the new administration building soon to be completed.

Mission: Happy Homes Pre-School of South Africa provides a refuge, care and educational opportunities for young children, age six months to six years, in a desolate area of South Africa.

JOURNEY OF HOPE GRIEF SUPPORT CENTER

Grant Amount: \$2,000

Grant Purpose: for program operations and volunteer and staff training Mission: Journey of Hope provides no-cost group grief support in 9 local Texas counties to children, adolescents, and their parents or adult caregivers who have lost a loved one to death.











KIDS U

Grant Amount: \$2,500

Grant Purpose: for M-F summer programs with breakfast and lunch are provided, along with educational opportunities including reading field trips and swimming lessons

Mission: Kids U improves the lives of at-risk children by concentrating on education and issues that affect the whole child. The programs operate on-site in low income apartment communities in Dallas at no cost to the families.

NEW FRIENDS NEW LIFE

Grant Amount: \$2,500

Grant Purpose: to provide funds for member/children expenses such as food, clothing, shelter, and counseling services, as they transition to self-sufficiency

Mission: New Friends/New Life restores and empowers formerly trafficked girls and sexually exploited women and their children by providing access to education, job training, interim financial assistance, mental health and spiritual support

ST. PHILIP'S SCHOOL & COMMUNITY CENTER

Grant Amount: \$5,500

Grant Purpose: for Community Center programs, such as afterschool care, their senior citizen program, and basic administrative costs Mission: St. Philip's provide an unparalleled education and community services through a faith-based experience to enhance the lives of children in South Dallas, with particular emphasis on low and moderate income families.

ST. SIMON'S AFTER SCHOOL

Grant Amount: \$5,000

Grant Purpose: to help fund one of the St. Simon's programs for 25

students in a DISD school for one school year

Mission: St. Simon's After School supports elementary school children and their families who are challenged by economic and family situations by providing a safe, familiar, nurturing place for children to be after school. This free care includes nutritional snack, and support and assistance with academic and social development.

THE GATHERING

Grant Amount: \$1,500

Grant Purpose: for winter hygiene kits given out to the homeless,

which include blankets, and thermals

Mission: The Gathering serves the homeless in downtown Dallas by celebrating an outdoor Eucharist at Thanksgiving Square each Sunday, and providing support of other physical and spiritual needs for those who attend.

VOICE OF HOPE

Grant Amount: \$4,000

Grant Purpose: to support Voice of Hope's out of school programs-ASPIRE After-school Program and Summer Day Camp, and the Early

Childhood Education and Care Program

Mission: Voice of Hope provides opportunities for children living in West Dallas neighborhoods with a focus on building strong character, providing education and life skills, and giving support to families.
