

Legos in Lent

On Wednesdays in lent we listen to a Parable, a Story Jesus told to teach people, and think about what Jesus is telling us in each story. We ask ourselves, what does Jesus want me to know or do? After we hear & wonder about the story, we will create something with Legos that reminds us of the story or shows what we think Jesus wants us to know or do.

Opening Lego Prayer

Get a Lego brick and hold it in your hand. Find a person with the same number of bumps on their Lego, go sit next to them.

Now pray a prayer thanking God for your family and friends and all who care for you. Then ask God to help you to be friends to those who are lonely. End your prayer with Amen. Then toss your Lego in the container in the center of the circle.

Today's story is from the New Testament.

Jesus is teaching

Reading: The Parable of true Friendship / Luke 11:5-10

Read it twice. First time listen for what the story is about. Second time listen to hear what Jesus wants you to know or do.

Wondering Questions: Pick a few or make up your own wonderings.

I wonder if you like to talk to God?

I wonder if you have heard or felt God talk to you?

I wonder if you have needed help from a friend?

I wonder if you have been a help to others?

I wonder if you have ever asked God for help?

I wonder how you might be a helper for God?

I wonder what Jesus wants you to know? Do?

Create: You are invited to respond to this story individually or as a group. I wonder what you would like to make about the story we just heard?

Share: Each person is invited to share what they have created. Explain what you made and what you think God wants you to know or do.

Closing Prayer:

Jesus, may we tun to you in prayer, trusting that you will always care for us. Let us never grow tired of offering praise, sharing our concerns and asking for your blessings. Amen.



*The Holy Gospel of Our Lord Jesus Christ According
to Luke [11:1–13]*

When Jesus finished praying, one of the disciples asked him, “Jesus, would you teach us to pray? John the Baptist taught his disciples how to pray.” So Jesus said, “When you pray, say, ‘Father, your name is holy. Bring your kingdom closer and closer. Give us what we need each day. Forgive what we do to harm our relationship with you and with others. Help us to forgive others when they harm us. Please don’t let our faith be tested.’” Jesus said, “If you go to a friend’s house at midnight, wanting to borrow three loaves of bread, would he say, ‘Go away and stop bothering me? I’m not getting up for you for any reason.’ No, a friend will hear what you need and try to help you. Don’t be afraid to ask God for what you want, or to look for what you need. Be bold and knock on God’s door! God will open it for you. If you ask, you’ll receive. If you seek, you’ll find. God loves you and wants to give you good gifts. He won’t give you a snake if you’ve asked for a fish, or drop a scorpion in your basket when you really wanted an egg.”
