THE POSITIONS

Episcopal Church of the Transfiguration seeks passionate disciples of Jesus Christ with gifts in leadership, preaching, and teaching to join our clergy team.

Senior Associate Rector

The Senior Associate is a “second chair” leader alongside the Rector, sharing in oversight of staff, participating in crafting and implementing vision, and practicing pastoral ministry for our thriving congregation.

The position is full-time and reports directly to the Rector. Priests with 3+ years of ordained ministry are invited to apply, with favor given to those who have served on the staff of a large congregational system.

- Skills for teaching and preaching in a compelling way
- Confidence presiding in a high-church style (sung liturgy)
- Humility, compassion, and a collaborative-mindset

Associate Rector

The Associate will work closely with the Rector and alongside the Senior Associate Rector to lead our congregation.

The position is full-time and reports directly to the Rector. Newly ordained clergy are welcome to apply, with favor given to those with previous congregational experience.

OPPORTUNITIES

The portfolio will be crafted according to the priest's passions, abilities, and skills. You might serve in any of the following capacities:

Supervision of Congregational Life

Transfiguration is home to over 40 ministries, and we have two staff personnel who assist with welcoming and connecting people into our community.

Guidance of Pastoral Ministries

In addition to leading pastoral visits, this role includes oversight of a part-time ordained pastoral associate and dozens of committed volunteers (e.g. Eucharistic Visitors, Prayer Shawls, Daughters of the King)

Leadership of Formation Ministries

Transfiguration proudly conducts a rich and diverse formation ministry for all ages, including multiple Sunday classes, special programs, Lenten series, an extensive adult catechumenate, and spiritual retreats. The staff includes separate directors of children and youth ministries.



Coordination of Outreach Ministries

Transfiguration actively serves the needs of our neighbors through three major feeding ministries and numerous other significant agency partnerships.

We put a lot of blessings into the world, and such thriving outreach requires the support of a member of our clergy team.

Coordination of Liturgical Ministries

Transfiguration conducts five weekly services (three on weekends and two on weekdays) that welcome nearly 600 on average each week. Over 100 different volunteers are regularly a part of our worship life, and this requires careful oversight.

Our two new clergy will begin together at an exciting moment in the life of our church, as we conduct a strategic planning process and set bold goals for the next five years. The specific roles and responsibilities attached to each new clergy position, including the Senior Associate, will be discerned through this search process.



SERVING ON OUR TEAM



- On a Sunday morning, you will help us lead worship in our congregation whose **attendance averages is 530**. Liturgical roles are shared generously!
- On a Tuesday morning, you will work with our exceptional team in a collaborative, supportive environment.
- On Tuesday night, you might help us serve a meal at St. Jude Center, which provides a home for our chronically unhoused neighbors.
- On Wednesday night, you might spend time with our youth group which serves teenagers from across Dallas.
- On Thursday, you might make pastoral visits or celebrate the Eucharist at a local retirement home
- On Friday, you might write a sermon or plan your next class.
